 Over 15 Million blind individuals in India (Accounts for 1/3 of World's blind population)

2.3 Million people develop cataracts every year

• 2 Million blind children - only 5% receive any Education


Exponential Power of Prevention



27 July 1998

Impact so far

- Over \$4 million raised since 1991
- 170,000 free Cataract operations
- One Million people got free eye sight checkups
- 750,000 children examined for their eye sights, provided glasses, vaccinated against Measles, and provided Vitamin A
- 10,000 Braille Kits given to blind children
- 121 Mobile Vans donated in 18 States of India
- 15 major projects done with Rotary Matching (1 to 3 match → \$500,000)
- Collaboration with Lions SightFirst Program


